



Deputy Nursing Officer/Clinical Director for Midwifery and Women's Health

Seed Global Health is a 501(c)3 non-profit entity that helps save lives and improve health by educating midwives, nurses and physicians in Africa. We do this because we believe in a future in which every country has a robust health workforce that is able to meet the health needs of its population.

Seed works through a variety of partnerships to strengthen in-country nursing, midwifery and physician education, thus supporting a stable supply of qualified health professionals in countries with dire shortages. Our flagship program, The Global Health Service Partnership (GHSP), a collaboration between Seed, the US Peace Corps and PEPFAR places nursing, midwifery and physician educators as visiting faculty for one year in Uganda, Tanzania, Malawi, Swaziland and Liberia. Seed also places nursing and midwifery educators in clinically based settings to complement the GHSP program.

The **Deputy Nursing Officer/Clinical Director for Midwifery and Women's Health** will play a leading role in midwifery and women's health nursing for GHSP and Seed initiatives and strategy. This individual will report directly to the Chief Nursing Officer and will collaborate closely with the Seed nursing team, as well as US and African team members and partners. This is a part time position (20 hr/week), based in Boston, Massachusetts, that requires a dynamic individual who is experienced and passionate about nursing education, midwifery and global health nursing.

Responsibilities will include but are not limited to:

1. GHSP midwifery nurse educator recruitment strategy and events, applicant interviews, selection, and matching;
2. Support GHSP site selection processes through application evaluation and site visits;
3. Participate in pre-departure orientation and in-service training;
4. Provide remote and on-site clinical and educational support to GHSP nurse educators;
5. Collaborate with monitoring and evaluation team to support collection of relevant data from all stakeholders;
6. Travel to Seed/Peace Corps sites to provide support to GHSP and Seed nurse educators, provide input regarding on-going site development and lend clinical midwifery expertise;

7. Develop midwifery focused educational materials, resources and pedagogical support to nursing volunteers in the field;
8. Identify and support Seed initiatives and partnerships related to midwifery;
9. Other duties as assigned.

SKILLS/ABILITIES/COMPETENCIES REQUIRED: Must be realistic, objective, measurable and related to essential functions of this job.

1. Established midwifery practitioner with leadership and networking experience in the midwifery community.
2. Ability to work independently, multi-task, and deliver polished, professional outputs of outstanding quality on time and with minimal supervision;
3. Ability to be organized and flexible in an environment that requires continuous monitoring of priorities;
4. Excellent verbal and written communication skills;
5. Demonstrated cross-cultural sensitivity and ability to build respectful relationships with colleagues from different cultural, linguistic, and educational backgrounds;
6. Demonstrated ability to teach in the clinical and/or classroom setting and experience with practice improvement projects;
7. Candidate should be prepared to travel several times per year to settings with basic accommodations.

LICENSES, CERTIFICATIONS, and/or REGISTRATIONS (if applicable): Specify minimum credentials and clearly indicate if preferred or required

Active license as a Certified Nurse Midwife is required.

The position requires a masters degree as an APRN/CNM.
